

ORDINANCE NO. 02 OF 2015

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE UNSAFE DRIVING OF A VEHICLE UNLAWFUL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS


Section 1. Any person who operates any motor vehicle on any street, alley, highway, public parking lot, or any area where the public is invited, in such a manner as to indicate an unsafe or hazardous disregard for his safety or the safety of any other person whether it be a passenger, a pedestrian, or operator of another motor vehicle or property shall be guilty of unsafe driving.

Section 2. "Operate" shall be defined as driving or being in actual physical control of a motor vehicle upon a street, alley, highway, public parking lot, or any area where the public is invited.

Section 3. Every person convicted of unsafe driving shall be punished upon a first conviction by imprisonment for a period of not less than five (5) days nor more than thirty (30) days, OR by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment in addition to court costs.

Section 4. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
