## ORDINANCE NO. 01-2020

AN ORDINANCE TO APPOINT PROPERTY OWNERS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS TO SILVER SPRINGS PROPERTY OWNERS' RECREATIONAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 30 OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2002, the City of Haskell, Arkansas, by Ordinance No. 5-2002, established Silver Springs Property Owners' Recreational Improvement District No. 30 of Haskell, Arkansas (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the original Commissioners of the District, Douglas W. Loftin, Jr., William W. Hope, Jr., and Brenda G. Hope, have resigned; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5-2002 was ratified by Ordinance No. 04-2011 on July 11, 2011 appointing C. Glynn Goss, Jr., Edwin L. Simmons and John Pendleton as Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the District, C. Glynn Goss, Jr., Edwin L. Simmons and John Pendleton, have resigned leaving the Board with vacancies; and

WHIEREAS, all improvements in the District have been completed; and

WHEREAS, the District has petitioned the City Council pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-94-107(a)(2)(A), seeking to name Brad Siverd, Kevin Stanford and Chuck McAllister, as Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the sole bondholders of District debt, Duke Family Limited Partnership, LLLP, has joined in the Petition.

WHEREAS, Brad Siverd, Kevin Stanford and Chuck McAllister are willing to serve as Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HASKELL, ARKANSAS, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That Brad Siverd, Kevin Stanford and Chuck McAllister are named as Commissioners of Silver Springs Property Owners' Recreational Improvement District No. 30 of Haskell, Arkansas (New Bedford Residential Subdivision Project). Brad Siverd, Kevin Stanford and Chuck McAllister are directed to file their Oaths of Office within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this ordinance with the Haskell City Clerk.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. <u>Severability.</u> If any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way effecting the validity of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. <u>Repealer</u>. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. . The immediate ratification of actions taken to date are necessary for the City to properly and timely perform tasks required of the City of Haskell and any delay in the same, adds intolerable inconvenience to the delivery of necessary services to the public. Therefore, an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. It shall be in full force and effective immediately from and after this passage and approval.
